NRA FIRST Steps Pistol Course

Overview: FIRST (Firearm Instruction, Responsibility and Safety Training) Steps is one of the latest additions to the NRA's training programs for new shooters. It provides hands-on orientation for one specific pistol. Teaching only the most basic shooting skills, this is an excellent introductory pistol course. This course meets the education prerequisite for an Oregon concealed handgun license.

Price: \$55

Goal: "To provide beginning shooters with an introduction to the knowledge, skills and attitude necessary to own and use a specific pistol model safely."

Prerequisites: There are no prerequisite training for taking this course. Students will be asked to sign a waiver and indemnification contract. You must be able to legally possess a firearm.

Course Completion: Students will receive feedback on their shooting exercise and an NRA course certificate upon successful completion of the lessons.

Materials Given to Student: Basic Pistol Shooting Handbook, NRA Gun Safety Rules Brochure, Basic Firearm Training Program Brochure, Course Completion Certificate, Basic Practical Rocker Patch and Flyer and Marksmanship Qualification Program Booklet. Includes targets, and range fees. School pistols and ammunition are available for a \$15 fee.

(NRA FIRST STEPS CONTINUED)

Required Equipment: Students may bring their own unloaded handgun, owner's manual and 50 rounds of ammunition. Please bring a billed hat, hearing and eye protection. Your prescription polycarbonate glasses can also serve as eye protection.

Lessons: This course, because of its narrow focus, can be completed in four to five hours. Students will receive practical lessons on the safe use, cleaning, and storage of their pistol. The firing exercise covers a single pistol.

- Introduction to Pistol Safety, Parts and Operation.
- Introduction to Ammunition and the Fundamentals of Pistol Shooting.
- Introduction to Pistol Cleaning, Storage and Training Opportunities.
- Introduction to Pistol Shooting from the bench rest and other positions.

- Procedures - How to apply for an Oregon CHL and what to expect.
- Situations - Make the decision to protect yourself.
